Program Summary

Elisha Ministries provides services for chronically homeless individuals suffering from a mental illness or a severe disabling condition. Individuals may apply for housing via walk-in, street outreach, internet application, referral from law enforcement, or from a psychiatric hospital.

The purpose of this grant is to provide salary support for Elisha Ministries case managers whose primary responsibility is to assess and plan specific mental, medical, and dental services that may be required for Elisha Ministries' chronically homeless and mentally ill residents. Lincoln Health Foundation's funding support is used by Elisha Ministries exclusively for program residents who originated in Lincoln Parish.
